DIRECTIONS TO THE MOUNTAINEER KENNEL CLUB BUILDING **953 POINT MARION ROAD**

From I 68 EAST – COMING FROM BRUCETON MILLS/CUMBERLAND: Take exit 7 (705 - Airport - Pierpont Road). At the end of the ramp, turn right. Proceed through three stoplights. Please note that 705 will become 119 North at the second stoplight. Follow 119 North. At the third stoplight, there will be an All Star Express on your right. Our building is 0.8 miles after that stoplight on the left side.

From I 68 West – COMING FROM FAIRMONT: Take exit 7 (705 - Airport - Pierpont Road). At the end of the ramp, turn left and follow the I 68 east directions above.

I 79 Southbound: Take exit 68 East and follow the I 68 east directions above.

Pennsylvania: Follow 119 S to the Pennsylvania/West Virginia border. Our building is 3.1 miles on the right hand side of the road. (0.4 miles south of the intersection of Baker's Ridge Road with 119 S in WV.)



OBEDIENCE CLASS DESCRIPTORS

PUPPY CLASSES

Puppy Playschool

\$85.00 – Class ONLY
\$90.00 – Class and STAR
Tuesdays, 8:00 PM

For puppies 12 to 20 weeks of age. The emphasis of this class is on socialization of the puppy, relationship building with the owner, and prevention of common canine problems. Pups will be taught to accept handling, take treats gently, develop a soft mouth (stop puppy nipping), and build confidence in their greetings with both people and other dogs. Basic obedience exercises will be introduced (sit, down, come, stay, and walk on a loose leash). Information on basic dog care will be presented. Motivational methods will be used (food, toys, relationship with the dog). The objective of this class is to develop a well-socialized puppy with basic obedience skills.

OPTIONAL: AKC S.T.A.R. PUPPY PROGRAM

If you choose to participate in this program: in order to pass, you must attend all six classes and pass the STAR test with your puppy. You will then receive paperwork to send to the AKC so your pup can receive the STAR Puppy Medallion and you and your pup will be listed in the AKC STAR records.

- The pup may be purebred or mixed.
- The pup will be tested on nine behaviors taught in the puppy class; the test will be ongoing during the session.
- The handler must sign a Responsible Dog Owner's Pledge, have a written exercise plan for the pup, and a form of ID for the pup's collar.

BASIC BEGINNER CLASSES

FUN-damentals for the Family Dog – Part I

For dog/handler teams who have had no previous formal obedience training; or dog/handler teams who have graduated from a Puppy class, but need additional instruction on the basic exercises.

All the basic obedience exercises will be taught – attention to handler, walking on a loose leash, come when called, sit, down, and stay. Information on basic dog care will be included, in addition to enrichment activities such as games to play with your dog. The objective of this class is to make your dog reliable and consistent in his response to basic commands.

INTERMEDIATE CLASSES

Family Dog - Part 2

For dog/handler teams who have graduated from a FUN-damentals for the Family Dog class; or dog/handler teams who have graduated from a Puppy class and are reliable with basic commands.

This class will improve the consistency of your dog's newly acquired manners in a fun, but challenging way. In Family Dog – Part 2, we play obedience games, teach tricks, and create distracting situations that will encourage your dog to focus on you. The objective of this class is to have the dog respond reliably to cues from the handler in a variety of environments.

For dog/handler teams that have graduated from a FUN-damentals Part 1 or Family Dog Part 2; or dog/ handler teams who have graduated from a Puppy class and wish to pursue training in a structured class setting.

This class will problem solve and refine basic behaviors learned in previous classes. Loose leash walking, heeling, and recalls will be emphasized and fronts and finishes will be introduced. A great class for handlers who want to perfect basic behaviors or who are thinking of taking rally or competition obedience classes in the future. The objective of this class is to have a dog that understands and can perform all basic commands. The class is a good preparation for the CGC (Canine Good Citizen) test, Therapy dog registration, rally, or competition obedience work.
